#### Alabama

- 70.5% of persons without disabilities aged 18 to 64 are employed.<sup>3</sup>
- ❖ 27.1% of PwDs aged 18 to 64 are employed.<sup>3</sup>
- ❖ 23,800 persons aged 16 to 20 have a disability.¹
- 757,829 people with a disability live in the community.<sup>3</sup>
- The Employment Gap between PwDs and people with disabilities has decreased 0.6 % pts between 2010 and 2011.3
- ❖ 264, 264 People ages 18-64 received SSDI or SSI benefits in the year 2012.³
- ❖ In 2012, AL's total expenditure on SSDI benefits for PwDs was \$3,365,544,000.3
- ❖ Voc. Rehab. obtained 4,577 jobs for PwDs in AL in 2012.<sup>2</sup>
- ❖ Voc. Rehab. received 10,157 general applicants in AL in 2012.<sup>3</sup>



Prevalence Rates: Age 16 to 20 years (%)



# Prevalence of Disability Among Non-Institutionalized People Ages 21 to 64 in Alabama in 2012


Prevalence Rates: Age 21 to 64 years (%)
