# Massachusetts



Gov. Charlie Baker (R)

- 77.9% of persons without disabilities aged 18 to 64 are employed.<sup>3</sup>
- ✤ 34.9% of PwDs aged 18 to 64 are employed.<sup>3</sup>
- 29,600 persons aged 16 to 20 have a disability.<sup>1</sup>
- 361,800 persons aged 21 to 64 have a disability.<sup>1</sup>
- 782, 204 civilians with a disability live in MA.<sup>3</sup>
- The employment gap between PwDs and people with disabilities has decreased 1.3% between 2010 and 2011.<sup>3</sup>
- 228, 904 people aged 18-64 in MA received SSDI or SSI benefits in 2012.<sup>3</sup>
- In 2012, the total expenditure in MA on SSDI benefits was \$2,942,436,000.<sup>3</sup>
- Voc. Rehab. obtained 3,847 jobs for PwDs (out of 10,731 applicants) in MA in 2012.<sup>3</sup>



Prevalence Rates: Age 16 to 20 years (%)



Prevalence Rates: Age 21 to 64 years (%)


